Description:

The Nebraska Music Teachers Association is offering a one-time \$1000 scholarship recognizing the musical study, musical achievement, musical contributions, and good citizenship of a high school senior studying with a current member of NMTA. The winner will be chosen on the basis of merit only. The judge reserves the right not to award this scholarship.

Requirements:

The applicant must be a senior in high school planning to graduate in 2021. He or she must be a student of a current NMTA member, whose membership dues must be paid by September 1, 2020.

Application:

Complete the application below and submit with it:

1. A summary of your musical training
2. A list of all NMTA/MTNA events in which you have participated
3. A list of other musical activities in which you have participated
4. A list of your musical and non-musical volunteer activities
5. A brief description of your future plans, career goals, and aspirations
6. An essay describing your musical journey or what music means to you
7. Two letters of recommendation: one from your current applied music teacher and one from another person of your choice. Recommendations must be mailed directly to the NMTA Scholarship Chair by the person submitting them.
8. An unedited performance video submitted via YouTube. The performance should contain two contrasting pieces from different periods of music and not be longer than 15 minutes. Composition students should submit a printed score with an audio recording.
